DEPARTMENTAL SUMMER VACATION STUDENTSHIP

Due to the generous support of alumni, the Biochemistry Department will fund the award of £200 per week (up to a maximum of £1600) annually to up to 2 students wishing to work in a research laboratory over the summer vacation.

- 1. The studentship is available only to students registered on the M Biochem. course in Oxford, and wishing to work in a research group within the Biochemistry Department in Oxford.
- 2. The application should be made by the student, and should include
 - a) name, college and year of course of the student
 - b) a brief statement by the student indicating why they are interested in this project
 - c) a brief statement of support by the proposed laboratory head

(a, b and c together should take up less than 1 side of A4)

- 3. Preference will be given to students who have applied for funding from an outside body for the same period. However, the Departmental Studentship cannot be held concurrently with a Vacation Studentship awarded by any other body, and if such an award is made, the Departmental Studentship will pass to the next eligible candidate.
- 4. Preference will be given to students taking up the studentship between their second and third years of study. Otherwise the award will be allocated by random ballot.
- 5. Applications must be submitted to the Teaching Office by noon, Friday Week 0, Trinity term.
- 6. The student will be required to submit a report of the project by the start of Michaelmas term to the Teaching Office.
